

The city of Jyvaskyla/the Alvar Aalto Museum and Helsinki University of Technology organised an international student architectural competition whose purpose was to design a boat shelter for the wooden boat designed by Alvar Aalto in the 1950s. The construction was intended to be light, ecological and feasible.



The boat, named "nemo propheta in patria" was famed as the fastest wooden boat on Lake Paijanne. Currently not functional, it is part of the collection of the Alvar Aalto Museum and will be moved to Muuratsalo, where Aalto's summer home is located.
